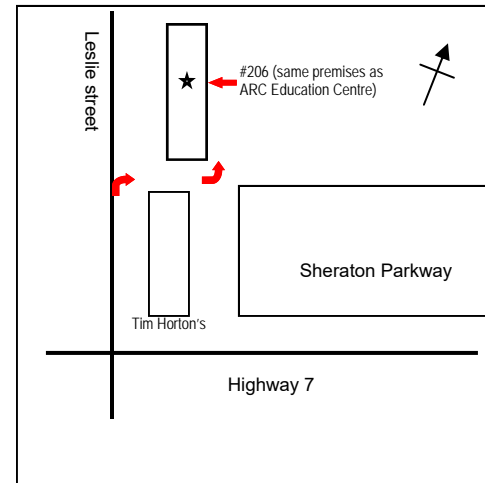
Group Lesson Policy

- Registration:
 - Registration for each course is required for both new and return students. Please register at www.ViaMusica.com. In case of the classroom is full, acceptance to the on-location course is first-come-first-serve based on the registration time stamp, overflow students can still enrol the course online.
 - If the student wishes to take a course without first completing the prerequisite course(s), he must take a placement test to qualify. He will not be allowed to skip ahead if failing the placement test.
- Tuition and Fees:
 - Tuition and applicable fees are paid in full at the beginning of the term. Cash, cheque or InterAct e-Transfer accepted.
 - An one time, non-refundable \$25.00 registration fee is applied to new students.** Siblings receive \$5.00 discount.
 - There is no discount on tuition when multiple courses are taken in the same term.
 - For returned cheque (NSF, stopped payment, etc): a \$30.00 (per transaction) administrative fee will be charged.
 - Via Musica purchases materials on behalf of the students as a free service. Once the order is submitted, there will be no refund nor return. Students must use the specified textbooks, but not obligated to purchase through the school. Outdated edition or alternative textbooks are not accepted.
 - Should there be any damages to instruments, equipment, or the premise caused by the student and/or his/her company, the student will be responsible for the repair, or replacement of the damaged items.
- Withdrawal and Refund:
 - A written withdrawal & refund request must be submitted to the office. No show is considered and treated as withdrawal.
 - Withdraw before the first class: \$30.00 withdrawal fee will be deducted before refund.
 - Withdraw before the fourth class: \$30.00 withdrawal fee plus the pro-rata tuition will be charged.
 - Withdraw after the fourth class – no refund thereafter.
- Examination Application:
 - Examination application is student's responsibility, Via Musica will not automatically apply on student's behalf.
 - Online application for RCME examinations is available at www.rcmusic.com/examinations/. Paper application submission will cost extra.
 - Application submitted after deadline is subjected to late fee and paper handling fee, charged by RCME.

- Course Expectation:
 - Students must pay total attention in class. Phone, messaging, portable media, social networking, etc, are not allowed.
 - Students must not disrupt the flow of the class, the teacher reserves the right to remove student from class if necessary.
 - Students must promptly submit homework. Regular review of material taught is expected to keep pace with the course. Homework marking is based on first-come-first-serve. Priority goes to those who promptly submit their work, late submission may not be marked.
 - Students are expected to participate and interact in class projects, group studies and assignments as part of the learning process. Extra session might be added when necessary.
 - Full-scale mock exams run on the last two weekends extra to regular classes.
 - Via Musica does not, and cannot guarantee exam result, for students' effort and dedication affect the outcome greatly.
- Online Lesson:
 - Students must have high-speed internet, a SKYPE account, webcam, headset with mic, scanner, and a fast computer.
 - Students must position himself/herself in a quiet location, free from any distractions such as TV, radio, family, IM, social networking, etc.
 - Online lessons are "live" sessions, students must sign on promptly, class participation is expected.
 - Via Musica will provide reasonable technical aid to setup online lessons, however, the school does not provide ongoing technical support.
- Access to Student Resources:
 - All class lessons are recorded for review purposes. Student are encouraged to use this online facility to aid their study. Student ID and password will be given to currently enrolled students for the duration of the course.
 - All recordings are copyrighted intellectual property of Via Musica. Students are not allowed to share, to give away the password, or to view the content with any non-Via Musica students in any which way. Failing to do so will lead to termination of access, and/or legal consequences.
- Lesson Rescheduling and Cancellation:
 - If students are unable to attend class for any personal reason, there is no make-up. However, lesson recording is available for review.

We reserve the right to cancel, or change the course schedule if a minimum enrolment is not met.

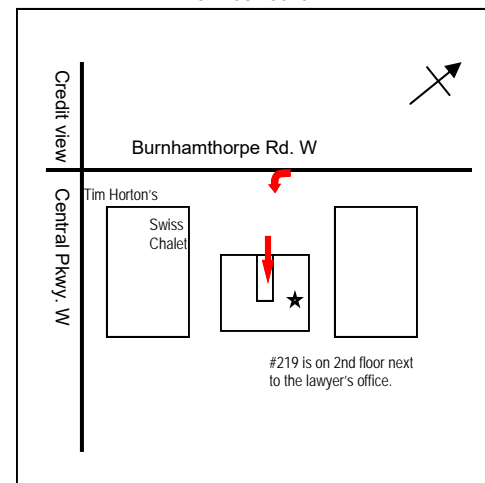

With trumpet being his primary instrument, he is equally at home with guitar, bass, and clarinet. Benedict has studied trumpet under Scott Harrison in the lineage of Vincent Chichowicz, and Shawn Spicer. He has been teaching instruments and theory for many years. Benedict is actively teaching privately, as well as operating his music & arts studio Arc Education Centre in Richmond Hill. Benedict is also an accomplished audio-visual specialist, with years of experiences in production of various events, from house of worship gatherings to large scale conferences.

Dennis Chan RCM Examiner, Theoretical Subjects. Dennis Chan holds two conducting degrees: a BFA from Cornish College of the Arts, Seattle; and a M. Mus from University of Washington. He also holds ATCL Diplomas in both violin and voice. Mr. Chan studied conducting with Prof. Stanley Cheng (Baptist University, HK) in lineage of Dr. Richard Lin, Dr. Byron McGilvray (SFSU), Dr. James Savage (Cornish), and Dr. Abraham Kaplan (UW). He studied violin Mr Kin-Wah Yau since 9 years old, later with former Kronos Quartet member Mrs. Ella Gray. He studied music theory under the tutelage of famous American composer Bern Herbolzheimer, as well as Janice Giteck in lineage of Darius Milhaud and Olivier Messiaen. Mr. Chan has years of experience in conducting and teaching in HK, USA & Canada; he is an active member of the College of Examiners of The Royal Conservatory since 2006.

Jade Wan Ms. Jade Wan is an accomplished pianist who began her music studies from Douglas College (BC), then completed her B.Mus in Music Education with a minor in Linguistics from University of Toronto. She studied piano under the tutelage of Dr. Barry Barrington, Dr. Leslie Kinton, and Mr. Boris Zarankin. After attaining intermediate performance knowledge of multiple orchestral instruments, she pursued short-term studies in Conducting at the Canford School of Music in UK under the direction of George Hurst. Ms. Wan also volunteered as the assistant conductor with the Royal Canadian Air Cadets of the 800 Black Forest Squadron. With many years of teaching experience behind her, she continues to regularly prepare her students for recitals, competitions, and the Royal Conservatory of Music examinations.
